Thursday, August 19, 2010 –Lecture by Catherine Jordan, “Fabric Painting” – Come and enjoy a short lecture and hands-on viewing of the many possibilities of using textile paints to complement a variety of needlework techniques. Catherine will share her adventures with fabric paints beginning with her first needlework map projects to later works encompassing the painting of entire pieces. Examples on linen, silk and felt will give you ideas of how color can change the appearance, mood and message of your art work.

Friday & Saturday, August 20 & 21, 2010 – “**Great Lakes Map Workshop**”, a needlework map workshop by Catherine Jordan. Design Size: 14 x 11. The map depicts the lakes and surrounding areas with details found in vintage pen and ink hand-drawn and painted maps. This class will introduce students to all the fine details of making reversible map lines as well as completely straight couched meridian lines. The water areas will be hand-painted and the maps will be customized with home towns, special motifs and lettering to create a wonderful personalized heirloom for each student. A companion friendship booklet cover accompanies the map so that students can practice fabric painting on a smaller piece.
