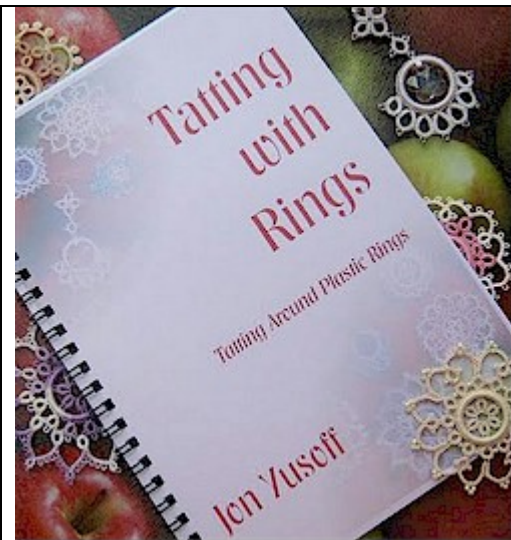

Jon Yusoff's latest book, *Tatting with Rings*, is available now. Jon says,

The designs in the book are worked around plastic rings that are wrapped with double stitches... There are basically three groups of designs;

1. Starter motifs that can be expanded upon with your own imagination.
2. You can get ideas on how to that from the second group of designs. In this set, I have added a second round to the main centre motif.
3. The third set are designs of earrings. They are a bit more involved but can easily be achieved after you have accomplished the starter motifs.
